Notes for all Club members using Southwater Lake

Club equipment

- A current membership card must be produced by any member wishing to use Club equipment.
- All club equipment borrowed for the evening must be collected from the duty Committee Member.
- No member must take any piece of club equipment from the hut without the knowledge of the duty Committee Member.
- During the evening no piece of equipment must be left unattended at the lake side.
- All club equipment borrowed for the evening must be returned to the duty Committee member at the hut by the member who borrowed it.
- Any damage to any piece of equipment must be reported to the duty Committee member when the equipment is returned.
- No equipment is to be used by non-members without the consent from a current committee member.
- All members using Club equipment are expected to use it responsibly.

Behaviour around and on the lake

- Members are expected to take note of HDC's notices relating to lake users.
- Members will not climb on any of the fences and gates around the pontoon and jetty.
- Members are expected to behave responsibly towards other lake users.
- Buoyancy aids must be worn by all persons on the water in any craft.
- Every lake user must be a fully paid up member to use the lake or have a separate permit to use the lake from Horsham District Council.
- Membership cards must be produced when asked for by a HDC Warden or a Police Community Support Officer. If not you may be asked to get off the water.
- No inflatables are allowed on the lake except craft designed for the purpose.
- Recreational use of the water by persons under the age of 16 is only permitted when an adult is in attendance.
- After loading/unloading all vehicles must be removed to a car park.
- Members failing to observe these regulations shall be liable to withdrawal of club membership.
